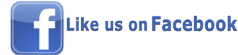




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## ADMINISTRATION

In May 2017, 61 students in grades 10 through 12 took AP Exams; 141 exams were administered in 11 different subjects; 63.2% of the scores were 3 or better, qualifying for college credit.

**Grade and Rank:** All students take at least seven courses each year. Cumulative GPAs include all course grades for each semester. The annual grade is computed by averaging quarter grades with semester exams. Class rank is based on all students and on all subjects. GPA and class rank are weighted. AP students are required to take the AP Exam. Placement is based on completion of requirements and AP potential from PSAT scores or teacher recommendations.
