Step 1. Find a current events article about a major news issue that involves each branch of the government either at the federal level. 1. Legislative Branch - An article involving the US Congress. 2. Executive Branch - An article involving the US President 3. Judicial Branch - An article involving the US Supreme Court

Step 2. Summarize each of the articles that you found into a 1 page summary and explain how the other branches of government are impacting the branch of government that the article is focusing on. (You will have a total of 3 pages.)

Step 3. Prepare a poster or collage pertaining to each of the articles to use as a visual aid when you present your summary of each article to someone.

Rubric

30 points - Article summary involving Legislative Branch will be graded for grammar and accuracy.

30 points - Article summary involving Judicial Branch will be graded for grammar and accuracy.

30 points - Article summary involving Executive Branch will be graded for grammar and accuracy.

10 points - Poster or collage will be graded for creativity and neatness.
