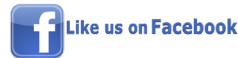

Advanced Placement:

In May 2018, 97 students in grades 9 through 12 took AP Exams; 198 exams were administered in 15 different subjects; 63.9% of the scores were 3 or higher, qualifying for college credit, compared to 55.6% of Florida Students and 61.3% of global students

Grade and Rank: All students take at least seven courses each year. Cumulative GPAs include all course grades for each semester. The annual grade is computed by averaging quarter grades with semester exams. Class rank is based on all students and on all subjects. GPA and class rank are weighted. AP students are required to take AP Exams. Placement is based on completion of requirements and AP potential from PSAT scores or teacher recommendations.
